



All experience levels and all types of dogs are welcome to participate.

Participants and their dogs can enter in any combination of events. Your dog **MUST** be physically capable of comfortably completing the distance you enter. If you don't have an actual live dog you can run with a stuffed animal dog or toy, just no cats, and realize that you will be a severe disadvantage to people with actual dogs that will be pulling them down the trail.

All races start at Pleasant Valley Store, mile 23 CHSR.

Bib pick-up (for those pre-registered) or race-day registration must complete by 10:00am, which is when the pre-race meeting will be held. Registration will open at 9:00 am inside the store.

- 10K Bikejor will start at 10:30 am with 30 second interval starts. Males and females (people) will be ranked in one class.
- 5K Canicross will start at 11:00 am with 10 second intervals. Males and females (people) will be ranked in separate classes.
- 1K Canicross Relay will start at 12:00 pm. It will be a mass start. Each leg will be 1K, there are 3 legs, the total race is 3K. Any combination of sexes can make up your three person relay team, but there must be three different people entered to constitute a team.

Equipment Requirements

Helmets and a shock absorbent line measuring 2.5 - 3 meters in length when extended are required for the bikejor class. All dogs, in all classes must be fastened to a harness and not attached at the neck. Please no muzzles.

Rules

A racer is finished when whichever part of your outfit crosses the finish line first, hopefully that part is the nose of your dog.

We will attempt to give small prizes to all participants, at least the top 3 of each class will get one, it just depends on how successful our ~~begging~~ donation gathering is.

If it makes sense for you for you to move over and stop to let someone from behind by, please do so, especially if they ask for trail, they caught you, most likely they are faster than you. Stay back there until it is obvious that you are actually faster than them, then politely ask for trail again.

If you couldn't tell, this is meant to be a laid-back, fun event, hence the name "FUNjor." If you want to get uber serious, this is not the event for you. Please just stay on the trail and be nice to your dogs, your competitors, and race volunteers. Failure to do any of these things will result in disqualification at the discretion of the race marshal.

Trail Description

All trails start and finish at Pleasant Valley Store. The trail will be marked with flagging, signs, and painted arrows on the ground. We are using multi-use trails and low-traffic public roads so please be aware. Trails are subject to change due to conditions. Changes will be announced at the pre-race meeting.
